

Deacon R.B. Cole Scholarship Guidelines

The Penny Hardaway Memphis District Golf Classic is dedicated to helping youth in the communities of Memphis, TN succeed. We believe that every child can and will learn with the proper educational resources and support. The Deacon R.B. Cole Scholarship is awarded by the Memphis District Laymen, an auxiliary of the National Baptist Convention USA, Inc. since 1936. Throughout the years, the Laymen have spearheaded many programs that make a difference in the lives of Mid-South youth. Each year, the Penny Hardaway Memphis District Golf Classic is held to raise funds for youth athletic programs and scholarships. 2024 is the third year the Deacon R.B. Cole Scholarship will be awarded. Two deserving students will receive an award of \$5,000 each. The honor will be announced publicly on September 12th of 2024 during the golf tournament reception. **NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the students upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution.**

Criteria and eligibility:

- 1. Applicant or their parent(s) or guardian must be a member of a participating church of the Memphis District Association.
- 2. Applicant must attend a local high school or a two-year college, four-year college, or trade school.
- 3. If in high school, the applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 4. Applicant must have at least a **3.0 grade point average**. (If you cannot provide your transcript, a copy of your last progress report/report card will be accepted. It must contain your overall GPA.)
- 5. Applicant must demonstrate leadership, community involvement, academic aptitude, and a desire to attend college.
- 6. Applicant must also write a minimum of one (1) page essay.
- 7. Applicant must present a letter of recommendation from the pastor of the Memphis District Association Church they and/or their parent(s)/guardian(s) attend.
- 8. Applicant must be willing to participate in future activities with the Penny Hardaway Memphis District Golf Classic. Recipients are also required to attend or record a video for the September reception when the scholarship is awarded.

The deadline for the application is **Wednesday, August 21, 2024, 5:00 p.m.** Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
